
Education Evolution



Forget for a moment how difficult it is to collaborate and work in and around a print text. How do you assess your students on how their learning? If you are like most professors, you give them exams, papers and projects to see how much information they have retained. This outdated approach is retroactive as you don't know how well the students have learned until after you have asked them to demonstrate knowledge of the material. This dogma is backwards. Wouldn't it be nice to see how your students are comprehending materials before the exam? That is where the Analytics come into play.

Our analytics can tell you what content students are understanding and what content needs further explanation. We can get as granular as saying John Smith was on page 17 of Chapter 7 last night from 10:53.55PM to 11:04.20PM. His Self-Assessment Rating is poor and he mentioned in a message that he did not understand the table. He posted a discussion question and another student anonymously answered his question. At 11:15.00PM he returned to page 17 and rated himself as proficient. His average time and Self-Assessment rankings exceed that of the class.

Now if John was viewing his course materials in print, how would you as a professor know what John was struggling with? Or if John actually did study when he said he spent over 3 hours studying last night. These insights are unparalleled in education. Instead of giving exams to see if learning has occurred, why not see learning as it occurs?

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

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QUIZZES


SELF-ASSESSMENTS

As students consume the course pack they will be periodically asked how well they are understanding the material. They can rate their understanding on a scale from extremely confused to complete comprehension. This technology also includes a timeout feature to understand why a student is on a page for an extended amount of time. This data is relayed back to illustrate comprehension of the material.



STUDENT FEEDBACK

When a student signifies that a chapter is completed, a more detailed Self-Assessment appears requesting users to state more detailed thoughts on the material. These questions can include items such as what the student found most difficult, what readings the student liked the best, what changes the student would like and more.

Qualitative and Quantitative Reporting

Omega Notes' patent pending interface collects and reports detailed analytics on student behavior within the Course Pack. We collect both qualitative (Notes students have taken, comments on other notes, Self Assessment reports) and quantitative (time spent per page, number of notes posted, number of comments, quizzes, Self Assessment scores) data.



Understand Who Needs Help

Frequently students are afraid to ask for help or ask when it is too late. With Omega Notes Analytics, you can track individual, group or total Course Pack behavior. Easily see if a particular student is struggling with a certain topic or even a specific page. Our analytics tell you how the student studied and how it relates to others in the classroom. As a professor, you have unbiased information on what the student actually studied and participated in.



Know Who to Teach

If students are spending unusually high amounts of time and continually scoring low on their Self Assessments on a specific page of the Course Pack, then they likely need help. Plus, with the Self Assessments, students have the opportunity to tell you what they are confused on, or whether or not the content was interesting. This information lets professors know what students want to see taught and what changes they would like to see to their learning.

FAQ

- **How does payment work?**

- Students pay for the materials just like they would for any normal text. The professor is not charged.

- **What determines the price of a Course Pack?**

- **How long does it take to get a Course Pack?**

- Depending on the copyright permissions needed, it can take anywhere from 2-3 weeks to create a course pack.

- Yes. Course Packs are living documents. However, if additional permissions are needed for new materials, an additional Course Pack may be required.

- **Is there any cost for the Notebook?**

- No. Use of the Notebook is included with the Course Pack.
